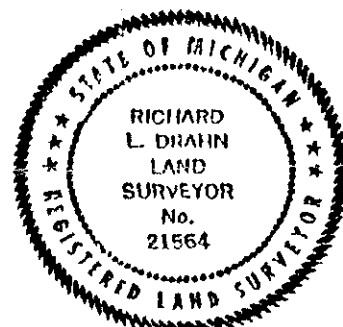
B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

All original evidence destroyed by road construction. Corner was re-established by single proportion measure on line between the S.E. corner and the S.W. corner of Section 5.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position and 6" below surface of an E-W road I set a 2" dia. by 12" long concrete filled, galvanized iron pipe with a 3" brass cap stamped: T.48N., R.37W; $\frac{1}{4}$; S.5, S.8; 1993; R.L.S. 21564: from which I established the following bearing trees and reference objects:

16"	White Pine	N.55°W.	51.10 feet
8"	White Spruce	N.29°W.	30.80 feet
6"	White Spruce	S.73°W.	35.94 feet
6'	Steel sign post	S.20°W.	22.52 feet

A standard 30" long, aluminum reference monument with a 3 1/4" alum cap, stamped to indicate corner position bears: S.19°E., 21.65 feet.
