Furthermore, that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were, in a field survey on \_\_\_\_\_ 19\_\_\_\_, found, recovered, restored, established or re-established as expressed below and in conformance with the rules of the Michigan State Board of Registration for Land Surveyors or, by a Decree of a Court of law:

**A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:**

- Corner J5: Wood post (Not found. No subsequent monuments found.)  
 Cedar 10 N56W 21 (Probably found)  
 Cedar 12 S54E 6 (Probably found)
- Corners J9 & L7: As these corners fall in long established county roads, any possible original evidence has long since been destroyed by construction.
- Corner 16: Not established in original survey nor subsequently, apparently.

**B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:**

- Corner J5: Re-monumented 10/25/73 from rotted stumps which correspond to the original BT's in species, absolute and relative size, distance, & bearing, and in alignment with section corners 39.536 ch. W (original corner) and 39.806 ch. E (not known to be original). Possible overgrowth scar remnants on stump to NW.
- Corner J9: Witnessed on 11/7/73 a 1-3/4 inch I.D. iron pipe found buried in approx. construction centerline of a county road, in line with an old N&S fence on S side of road. Appears consistent with other corners and fence lines along this road.
- Corner L7: Replaced on 11/7/73 a 1"x18" iron pipe found buried in the road bed at the intersection of construction centerlines of intersecting county roads. Appears consistent with long standing property line fences in the locality.

**C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:**

- Corner J5: 1" I.D. x 36" Iron pipe with 3 1/2" aluminum cap.  
 Cedar 12 S41°E (mag.) 37.9 ft. "1/4S, NBT"  
 Hemlock 10 S26°W (mag.) 13.2 ft. "1/4S, NBT"
- Corner J9: 1-3/4" I.D. iron pipe, length unknown.  
 Power Pole N60°W (mag.) 47.40 ft. ) Distances to head of a nail.  
 Fence Corner Post S10°W (mag.) 31.90 ft. )
- Corner L7: 1/2" I.D. x 24" iron pipe  
 Power Pole N51°E (mag.) 42.56 ft. ) Distances to head of a nail.  
 Power Pole West (mag.) 30.30 ft. )
- Corner 16: 5"x5"x6' squared cedar post scribed "1/16, 11, 14"  
 Red Maple 4 N46°E (mag.) 16.9 ft. "1/16S, BT"  
 Sugar Maple 11 N52°W (mag.) 8.5 ft. "1/16S, BT"
