On 22 April 1977, Keith Sackett, P.S. #19006 recovered and accepted a "1½ (in.) I.D. x unknown length iron pipe one foot above ground in line with roads north, south and west. Old blazed line east.". According to a Land Corner Recordation Certificate prepared by Mr. Sackett dated 3 August 1977 and recorded on 20 December 1977 in Volume 1 on page 483 of the Houghton County Land Corner Records, this monument was left in place and the following accessories were established:
