- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- (G9) Corner common to Sections 21-22-27-28. 1846 - Established by S.W.Higgins, Deputy Surveyor. post. Sugar 10" S80E 60 links, Maple 12" N50W 20 links. Notes of P.A. and M.C.Larsen: 1925 - "A birch stdg S.E. B.T. marks visible but not called for in field notes". 1953 - Dean C. DeLaMater RLS reestablished the corner by double proportionate measurement. No original evidence at corner. Set 1" pipe with 4" brass cap. 10" Hemlock N63W 38 links, 12" Hemlock S05E 11 links.
- (F9) Quarter corner common to Sections 21 and 28. 1846 Established by S.W.Higgins, Deputy Surveyor. Set post. Y.Birch 11" N35W 41 links, Sugar 13" S78E 6 links. Notes of P.A. and M.C. Larsen: 1925 - B.T. Birch stub burnt stdg - Set stake from same. 1980 - K.L.Sackett RLS found old post set by M.C.Larsen at intersection of blazed lines. Set 1"IDx30" Iron pipe with 4" aluminum cap. 10" Elm North 9.4', 18" Sugar S49W 12.8', 16" Sugar N29E 21.5'.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- (G9) Found the 1953 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the 1953 Hemlock NBTs, both in good condition with overgrown blazes. Found monumented corners 2660.41' north, 2691.22' west, 2643.55' east, and approx. 2641' south. 1953 field notes located at the MI Dept. of Natural Resources office in Baraga suggest that the "double proportionate measurement" referred to in the 1953 record may have been based, in part, on the distances to stream calls given in the original record.
- (F9) Found the 1980 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the 1980 The Sugar SW is in good condition with overgrown blazes, the Elm North is dead and down, witnesses. the Sugar NE is a rotting cut stump. Accepted the monument as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- (G9) Found 1"ID I.pipe with 4" brass MI Dept. of Conservation cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of: Hemlock S05E 7.6' old blaze 1953 NBT 16" 18" Hemlock N61W 25.6' do do mrkd "S22 NBT" 8" Sugar N68E 30.3' "S21 NBT" 6" Sugar N10W 20.4' Set sq'd Cedar post adjacent.

(F9) Found 1"ID I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of: 20" Sugar S52W 13.0' old blazes 1980 NBT 12" Hemlock N04E 13.9' mrkd "1/4S NBT" 4" Maple N80E 2.7' do 5" Sugar S59E 13.1' do Set sq'd cedar post adjacent. Bearings are magnetic.
