Being at a loss as to how to reconcile the calls of the original field notes with conditions actually encountered on the ground, I finally concluded that the most consistency was obtained by extending the section line from Sec. Cor. 22, 23, 26, and 27 (existing original) E'ly through the 1/4 cor. bet. Sec. 23 and 26 (existing original), and beyond, a distance equal to that between the aforementioned corners, and establishing the corner at that point. Found this point to check most favorably with stream crossings in the area. The original subdivision of this township was very erratic, and almost any corner position is plausible.
