Buckler RLS from the original BTs. The Cedar NE was found with scribing plain, the Cedar SW no marks. Set 1"I.pipe with 4" brass cap. 12" Cedar N62E 16 links, 12" Elm N59W 32 links.
- (L10) Center of Section 25. Not established in the original survey.
- B.
