- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
  - THE MONUMENT WAS OBLITERATED BY A CITY OF HOUGHTON CREW REPLACING A BROKEN WATER MAIN LOCATED DIRECTLY BELOW IT, IN THE FALL OR EARLY WINTER OF 1982. THE MONUMENT SET WAS A STANDARD MONUMENT; 36" LONG, CONSISTING OF A 1/2" REBAR ENCASED IN A 3 1/2" CYLINDER OF CONCRETE. AN "X" WAS FILED IN THE EXPOSD END OF THE REBAR. THE MONUMENT WAS SET WITH ITS TOP APPROXIMATELY 6" BELOW THE SURFACE IN ORDER TO PROTECT IT FROM GRADING EQUIPMENT, SET '4" IRON PIPE WITH 2 '4" BRASS CAP OVER RE-ROD IN MON. PREVIOUSLY RECORDED BY ROSWELL K. MILLER IN LIBER 1, PAGE 893.
