THE CORNER IS ON THE NORTH EDGE OF "OLD" SHARRON AVE, EAST OF GARNET IN HOUGHTON. PROBABLY RESTORED FROM THE ORIGINAL BY CIVIL ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT AT MTU, USED SINCE 1966 BY SURVEYORS IN FORESTRY DEPT AT MTU.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

THE MONUMENT WAS OBLITERATED BY A CITY OF HOUGHTON CREW REPLACING A BROKEN WATER MAIN LOCATED DIRECTLY BELOW IT, IN THE FALL OR EARLY WINTER OF 1982. THE MONUMENT SET WAS A STANDARD MONUMENT; 36" LONG, CONSISTING OF A 1/4" REBAR ENCASED IN A 3 1/4" CYLINDER OF CONCRETE. AN "X" WAS FILED IN THE EXPOSD END OF THE REBAR. THE MONUMENT WAS SET WITH ITS TOP APPROXIMATELY 6" BELOW THE SURFACE IN ORDER TO PROTECT IT FROM GRADING EQUIPMENT, SET 1/2" IRON PIPE WITH 2 1/2" BRASS CAP OVER RE-ROD IN MON. PREVIOUSLY RECORDED BY ROSWELL K. MILLER IN LIBER 1, PAGE 893.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

THE 1/2" IRON PIPE WITH 2 1/4" BRASS CAP WITNESSED WITH SURVEY TAG NAILED TO: 12" WHITE BIRCH TREE N26°W 36.93', 20" MAPLE TREE N29°E 40.17', 18" MAPLE TREE N65°E 68.55', 26" MAPLE TREE S20°W 39.89'.
