

5. Private Claims

Domitrovich, in a field survey on October 25, 1999, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(J - 5) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 11 & 14, T55N, R33W,

1846 L.S. Scranton set a post with ties:

- 1910 H.W. Holland shows this corner as a pin in concrete and gives a distance to Section corners east and west. (His notes on file with Lake Superior Land Company of Calumet)
- H.W. Fesing, Engineer, shows this corner as an I.P. in concrete, in his field notes and on his map of the Subdivision of Section 14, T55N, R33W. (On file with Steve Hein P.S. of Laurium)
- Steven Hein, P.S., 32336 recorded this corner. (L. 3, p. 301 of Corner Records) He found a 1 1/2" pin, bent with <u>1995</u> top portion broken off. He replaced it with a 5/8" pin. Ties:

Duane Wood, P.S. 24625, accepted and used Steve Hein's 5/8" pin, as part of the Houghton County Airport 1996 Survey.

B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing comer:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. The 5/8" pin called for by Steve Hein has been removed by sewerline construction work. I re-established the position of his 5/8" pin using remaining survey control. This position works well with his 4 remaining bearing objects. It falls at approximate intersection of gravel county roads: Oneco Road to East and West and Dover Road to North. It works well with occupation and other corners in area. I accepted Steve Hein's position as the 1/4 corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 3/4" iron pipe with a brass "Houghton County Remonumentation" cap placed on it. Ties:

88.31' (Existing Nail & Tag) **Utility Pole** N 71°E 8" Aspen S 32°W 57.89' (New nail) S 57°W 8" Spruce 68.97' (Existing Nail & Tag) 9" Spruce N 58°W 106.42' (Existing Nail & Tag)

NOTE: Bearings to witness objects are magnetic. Distances are to a nail in side of the witness object unless noted.
