I found no remains of original corner or accessories. I found no evidence of subsequent restoration. I found the I.P. (2" iron pipe) called for by Fesing to the East and recovered his SW section corner to the West. I re-established a position for the ¼ corner by prorating to Fesing's record distances. Distances from this position work well with Fesing's.
