- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - THIS IS THE CORNER COMMON TO FOUR TOWNSHIPS AND SECTIONS: , SECTION 1, T54N, R34W, CODE M-1, SECTION 6, T54N, R33W, CODE A-1, SECTION 31, T55N, R33W, CODE A-13, SECTION 36, T55N, R34W, CODE M-13.
 - THE CORNER IS ON THE NORTH EDGE OF "OLD" SHARRON AVE, EAST OF GARNET IN HOUGHTON. PROBABLY RESTORED FROM THE ORIGINAL BY CIVIL ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT AT MTU, USED SINCE 1966 BY SURVEYORS IN FORESTRY DEPT AT MTU.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
 - THE MONUMENT WAS OBLITERATED BY A CITY OF HOUGHTON CREW REPLACING A BROKEN WATER MAIN LOCATED DIRECTLY BELOW IT, IN THE FALL OR EARLY WINTER OF 1982. THE MONUMENT SET WAS A STANDARD MONUMENT; 36" LONG, CONSISTING OF A 1/2" REBAR ENCASED IN A 3 1/2" CYLINDER OF CONCRETE. AN "X" WAS FILED IN THE EXPOSD END OF THE REBAR.
