Cade called for a Cedar Stake but lists no accessories. Department of Conservation Surveyor D. Scott's (PS \$12029) retracement survey in 1964 of C.M. Cade's survey shows the distance to corner C9 to be 1310.5' but does not list what was found or give any accessories. Case Surveying of Bad Axe. MI in a 1970 survey of the South 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 20 shows "Corner post in place and the distance to corner C9 to be 1310.30'".

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

10: Recatablished corner on line between corners C9 and C8 at a distance of 1310.3° North of corner C9 per the 1970 survey performed by Case Surveying.
