B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 5/8" x 18" iron rod in centerline intersection - of roads.

No references remained from GLO or later surveys or LCRCs.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 3/4" diameter iron with County Remonumentation Cap in monument box and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. (Replaced, 5/8"x18" iron rod).
