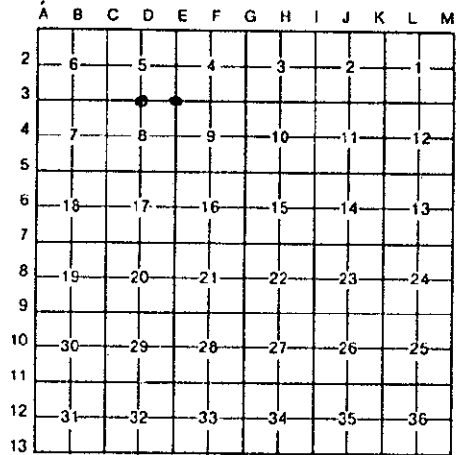

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

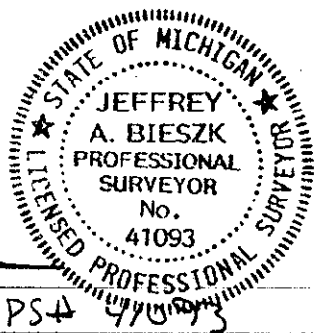
D-3: GEORGE MARK SET STONE AT CORNER IN HIS SURVEYS AND WITNESSED IT. KELLER FOUND IRON AND WITNESSED THIS AS THE CORNER. FROM MEASUREMENTS TAKEN FROM D-3 TO E-3 AND FROM D-3 TO C-3 THIS CORNER WAS NEAR THE SPLIT OF THE MILE AND FITS THE OCCUPATION TO THE SOUTH. ACCEPTED AS THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF THE POSITION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER.

E-3: DONALD OLMSTEAD SET R.R. SPIKE FROM STATE SURVEY CREW NOTES BASED ON F-3 AND A STONE AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 9. THIS CORNER FITS OCCUPATION IN ALL DIRECTIONS. ACCEPTED AS A CAREFUL AND FAITHFUL PERPETUATION OF THE POSITION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER.
