K-2: PART B, CONTINUED: UPDATE

AT THE REQUEST OF 1997 PEER REVIEW, THIS CORNER WAS TIED INTO THE SECTION BREAK-DOWN TRAVERSE TO DETERMINE ITS LOCATION. THIS TRAVERSE WAS PER-FORMED IN AUGUST OF 1998, AND THE LOCATION OF K-2 WAS DETERMINED TO BE AS FOLLOWS:

MEASURED NORTH 3035.85 FT., DRAKE = 3029.40 FT., BOSS = 3036.35 FT.; MEASURED SOUTH 2600.16 FT., DRAKE DOES NOT NOTE DISTANCE SOUTH; MEASURED EAST 2636.16 FT., BOSS = 2634.15 FT. (DRAKE SURVEY DOES NOT SHOW A DISTANCE EAST, HOWEVER AN APPROXIMATE PRORATION USING HIS MEASURED DISTANCES IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER-SECTION WOULD BE ABOUT 39.79 CHAINS = 2626.14 FT. +/- ALONG THE EAST-WEST 1/4 LINE. ALSO, THE CURRENT LOCATION IS VERY CLOSE TO THAT OF THE EXTENSION OF THE EAST-WEST 1/4 LINE EXTENDED WEST FROM CENTER OF THE SECTION, WHICH WAS EXCAVATED AND FOUND ON SEPT. 21, 1998. I ACCEPT THE LOCATION OF THIS CORNER AS A FAITHFUL PERPET-HATION OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER, BASED ON DRAKE'S SURVEY OF 1880, AND BOSS'S TESTIMONN OF 1973.
