A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

ELM 6, S1/2°W, 49 1/2 LINKS

BEARING TREES: ELM 16, N48°W, 44 LINKS

FOUND 1/2" BAR AND ALL THE WITNESSES, AS FND BY STEPHENS IN HIS C.R.C., AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE EAST-WEST & NORTH-SOUTH FENCE LINES. AN APPARENT TRENCH LINE FOR AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY LINE OBLITERATED THE ORIGINAL ANCHOR POST, AS RECORDED IN YOUNG'S C.R.C. EXCAVATED AROUND THE 1/2" BAR ±18" DEEP & FOUND A CIRCLE OF STONES WITH REMAINS OF WOOD POST IN CENTER. ACCEPTED THE 1/2" BAR AS THE CORNER MARKER & WITNESSED, SUPPORTED BY STEPHENS FINDING OF 2 OF THE 3 WITNESSES BY YOUNG. THE BAR IS SET IN THE CIRCLE OF STONES ON THE NORTHERLY EDGE OF THE POST REMAINS.
