Investigation at this location revealed the 1 1/4" steel shaft to be in place as set by Caulkins and reported by Steadman in 1975. Measured North 2659.16(Co. Surv. 2658.81') Measured East to 1" bar left by Caulkins 1329.15'(Caulkins 1327.92'). Set 1/2" bar and cap on South side of shaft. Falls in East-West fence line 27.6' East of fence corner post with fence to North only.
