Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: JOSEPH WAMPLER D.S. SET POST IN ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT SURVEY IN JULY 1824; BEECH 13", N45°W, 20 LKS, BEECH 21", S13½°W, 19 LKS.
2. T.J. BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, USED CORNER IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN VOLUME 2 PAGE 330 IN MARCH 1858 WITH THE SAME WITNESSES AS GLO. BROWN MEASURED WEST 693' TO A PARCEL CORNER, WEST 1353 TO ANOTHER PARCEL CORNER AND NORTH 2642' TO M-9. 3. M.W. BULLOCK, LIVINGSTON COUNTY SURVEYOR, SET A-10, T2N, R3E, IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN VOLUME 2 PAGE 55 LIVINGSTON COUNTY SURVEYORS RECORDS IN DECEMBER 1875. BULLOCK GAVE NO WITNESSES TO A-10 AND MEASURED NORTH 2651.22' TO A-9 AND SOUTH 2651.2' TO A-11.

4. THE INGHAM COUNTY REMONUMENTATION PROJECT OF THE LATE 1970S EXCAVATED A 21' EAST-WEST X 6' NORTH-SOUTH HOLE IN NOVEMBER 1977 AND FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF CORNER, THEY ALSO EXCAVATED A 7' NORTH-SOUTH X 10' EAST-WEST HOLE ON THE WEST EDGE OF KANE ROAD 115' NORTH OF THE RECORDED POSITION OF A-10 IOSCO TWP. AND FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF CORNER B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
SEARCHED AT APPARENT LOCATION OF CORNER IN THE CENTER OF KANE ROAD ON A FENCE LINE TO THE WEST AND FOUND
NO EVIDENCE OF CORNER. EXCAVATED 12' EAST-WEST X 10' NORTH-SOUTH HOLE ON CENTERLINE OF KANE ROAD ON THE
FENCE LINE TO WEST AND FOUND NO FURTHER EVIDENCE OF CORNER. EXCAVATED 10' X 10' HOLE 4' DEEP ON THE CENTERLINE OF KANE ROAD ON A FENCE LINE TO THE EAST WHERE I BELIEVE A-10 SHOULD BE AND FOUND A POINTED FLAT BLUE STONE SURROUNDED BY MORE STONES AND BROKEN CROCKERY. REPLACED BLUE STONE WITH A 5/8" REBAR & CAP # 25837. USING STONE AS THE BEST EVIDENCE OF THE LOCATION OF THE TOWNSHIP LINE SET A STANDARD MONUMENT. ON TOWNSHIP LINE ON FENCE LINE TO WEST. MEASURED WEST 693' +- TO AN ANCHOR POST AND WEST 1353 +- TO ANOTHER ANCHOR POST. I BELIEVE THAT BOTH OF THESE ANCHOR POSTS MARK PARCEL CORNERS SURVEYED BY BROWN IN 1858 AND THE DISTANCES MEASURED TO THEM MATCH HIS DISTANCES ALMOST EXACTLY, ACCEPTED THIS POSITION OF THE STANDARD MONUMENT AS THE BEST EVIDENCE OF THE LOCATION OF THE CORNER, MEASURED NORTH 2661,80' TO M-9, MEASURED SOUTH 2642,41' TO M-C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: M-10 T2N, R2E 3/4" X 24" SMOOTH STEEL BAR WITH 2½" ALUMINUM CAP STAMPED PA 345 INGHAM COUNTY 25837 ON CENTERLINE KANE ROAD SET NAIL & TAG #28409 NW SIDE 17" MAPLE, N25°E, 49.00' SET NAIL & TAG #28409 SW SIDE 20" MAPLE, S33°E, 34.69' SESSION TO THE SESSION OF MICHIGA FORM APPROVED BY MICHGAN STATE BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL SURVEYORS, JAN. 28, 1971 REVISED MAY 14,1975 REVISED JAN, 1983 REVISED OCT, 1995
