5. LCRC recorded by Richard W. Steadman PS #11370 in Liber 5 Page 19 on October 9, 1978 states "Found anchor post at the intersection of fences running North, South, East, and West.

5' Maple S10°W 15.7 feet

6. LCRC recorded by Kay Don fluke PS #18988 in Liber 6, Page 294 on June 17, 1985 states "Anchor post was destroyed by Bulldozing re corner from witnesses that were still in. Set 2" x 2" angle iron and put old fence post and stones by it and around it."

7. Unrecorded survey by Larry Bryan PS #25832 dated January 5, 1993 calls for "Found rock formation with broken of fence post 2' deep, bar and cap.

Nail and tag East side 16' Ash, S10°W 60.72'
Distance to A-10 = 2748.48 feet

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
