- 3. W.A. Rowe, County Surveyor, in survey No. 1831 dated May 1, 2, 3, and 4, 1895 and recorded in Volume 3, Page 232, County Surveyors Records labels corner as "B" and notes " point B was found from old witnesses made while the original marks could be found" describes marker as an Iron Shaft with the following witnesses:

Tamarac 6 S24-1/2W 166 (109.6)

Apple 12 S83E 75 (49.5)

Stone (?opped) N39W 77-1/2 (51.2')

Rowe shows 40.05 chains to north and to south.
