SEARCHED AT APPARENT LOCATION OF CORNER AND FOUND BOAT SPIKE IN MONUMENT BOX ON CENTERLINE COLUMBIA ROAD AND ON OLD FENCELINE TO NORTH. EXCAVATED THROUGH BOTTOM OF MONUMENT BOX TO A DEPTH OF 3' AND FOUND ONLY CLEAN YELLOW SAND. SURROUNDING SOIL IS DIRTY GRAY CLAY, ASSUMED THAT SAND WAS PLACED DURING ROAD CONSTRUCTION. ONE SIDE OF ROAD IS IN SLIGHT CUT SECTION AND OTHER SIDE IS FILL SECTION.
