- FROM INGHAM COUNTY DOSSIER, FOLDER 1, PAGE 1, DATED FEB. 18, 1901, E.A. CALKINS CO. SURVEYOR, ELM 6" N67 1/2E, 62 1/2 LINKS SURVEY ONLY APPLIED TO CORNERS AND DID NOT DESCRIBE MARKERS OR GIVE MEASUREMENTS.
- 2) A SURVEY WAS RECORDED IN LIBER 3, PGS. 578 & 579, DATED 11-3-77 BY A.S. PIERSON NO. 13039.
- "CONTINUED ON BACK" B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- FOUND DRIVE SHAFT AS DESCRIBED BY SURVEYOR STEADMAN IN EAST-WEST FENCE LINE. EXCAVATED 10 FEET WEST AND EAST ALONG FENCE LINES FROM THE SHAFT. DID NOT FIND ANY INDICATION OF THE CORNER. ACCEPTED THE DRIVE SHAFT AS SET BY STEADMAN AS A MARKER FOR THE CORNER. CORNER COMPUTED TO BE 2.13 FEET NORTH OF THE LINE BETWEEN D-2 (CENTER OF SEC. 5) AND A-2 (WEST 1/4 COR. OF SEC.6).

## "A" CONTINUED

THE SURVEY ESTABLISHED AN EAST-WEST 1/4 LINE FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6 TO THE CENTER OF SECTION 5. THE VICINITY OF C-2 WAS LABELED AS APPROXIMATE SECTION LINE BETWEEN SEC. 5 & SEC. 6.

3) A L.C.R.C. WAS RECORDED IN LIBER 5, PAGE 140, DATED MAY 7, 1973 & RECORDED JAN. 16, 1979 BY R.W. STEADMAN NO. 11370. "FOUND ANCHOR POST AT THE 1/8 POST NEXT EAST AND AT THE CENTER OF THE SECTION NEXT EAST. PROJECTED THIS LINE WEST AND SET CORNER THE SAME DISTANCE WEST OF 1/8 POST THAT 1/8 POST IS WEST OF CENTER OF SECTION. CORNER FALLS IN EAST-WEST FENCE".

"SET 2" IRON DRIVE SHAFT 4' LONG WITH 6" BELL END JUST ABOVE GROUND LEVEL TO MARK THIS CORNER."

7" BASSWOOD N.W 7.73' (FOUND TREE)

14" BASSWOOD W.SW 13.92' (FOUND TREE)

14" OAK E.SE 35.85' (FOUND TREE)

- 4) A SURVEY WAS RECORDED IN LIBER 5, PAGES 506-507 BY R. LESTER P.S. NO. 18998, DATED SEPT. 8, 1988. HE RAN A LINE BETWEEN THE CENTER OF SECTION 5 AND THE WEST 1/4 COR. OF SEC. 6, AND IGNORED THIS CORNER.
- 5) A SURVEY WAS RECORDED IN LIBER 4, PAGES 1012-1013 BY R. LESTER, DATED MARCH 13, 1985. A LINE WAS RAN BETWEEN THE SAME CORNERS AS 4-A ABOVE.
