Found a standard concrete monument in a monument box with a non-legible cap ±3' South of centerline Sandhill Road (Bituminous) and on fencelines North and South. Found witnesses: Nail and Tag #25832 East side 12" Oak S 15° E 26.58'. Nail and Tag #18998 North side 40" Oak S 76° W 108.02'. Excavation performed by Surveyor Lester P.S. #18998 as part of County Remonumentation in 1978. Accepted corner as set by Surveyor Lester P.S. #18998 in Liber 4, Page 293 and affixed a 2 1/2" aluminum cap stamped P.A. 345 #28414 over the standard concrete monument.

- 5. Ingham County Road Commission Map shows comer to be a 1" iron 2659.92' from F-3 (I.C.R.C. 1962) with the following witnesses: T.P. S 60.86', 24" Oak Southwest 34.68', 10" Elm N, 95.74'.
- 6. L.C.R.C. recorded in Liber 4, Page 293 by Ronnie M. Lester P.S. #18998 on August 23, 1978 Accepted 1" x 38" iron stake as comer after massive excavation of area revealed stake was surrounded by large rocks and bits of pottery. Set a 4" x 36" concrete monument with 1/2" x 38" rerod and cap #18998 in location of the 1" x 38" iron stake. Witnesses: Nail and Tag #18998 East side 6" Oak SSE 26.61'.
