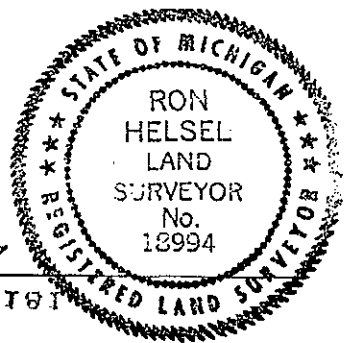

FOUND 5/8" REBAR IN MON. BOX 4.5 FEET NORTH OF C/L OF WILLOUGHBY ROAD AND 1 FOOT WEST C/L OF EVERY ROAD. EXCAVATED THROUGH MON. BOX AND FOUND POINTED STONE AND PIECES OF RED BRICK AS FOUND AND WITNESSED IN L.C.R.C. IN LIBER 3, PAGE 181. ACCEPTED THIS MARKER AS FAITHFUL PERPETUATION OF THE CORNER. REPLACED BAR WITH 3/4"x 24" FORM PIN AND CAP LABELED P.A. 345, P.S. NO. 18994.
