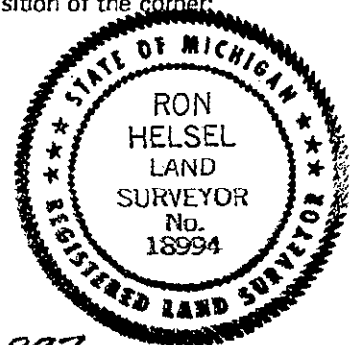

- VOL. 2, PAGE 152, JUNE 15, 1879, COUNTY SURVEYOR, A. P. DRAKE CALLED FOR A STONE & WITNESSED "S W COR. OF S HOUSE, N29°40'E, 176 LINKS "
- THE INGHAM CO. ROAD COMM. GRID MAP CALLED FOR AN IRON SHAFT AND BRICK, SW COR. SCHOOL HOUSE , NE, 135.1'; (FOUND EXISTING RESIDENCE AT THIS LOCATION); 6" CATALPA, NE, 43.9'; ANCH. POST W, 26.0'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
FOUND 1/2" IRON BAR 1 FOOT WEST OF C/L OF EVERY ROAD ON LINE WITH AN ANCIENT FENCE AND TREE LINE TO THE EAST. EXCAVATED 2.0 FEET DEEP AND FOUND A 1" AXLE SHAFT SURROUNDED WITH RED BRICK AT OLD CLAY ROAD BED AND DIRECTLY UNDER THE 1/2" BAR. IT APPEARS THAT AN ADDITION HAS BEEN ADDED TO THE OLD SCHOOL HOUSE WHICH EXPLAINS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE ICRC GRID MAP WITNESS AND DRAKES WITNESS. ACCEPTED THE POSITION OF THE AXLE SHAFT AS FAITHFUL PERPETUATION OF THE CORNER AND SET A 3/4" BY 24" FORM PIN AND CAP STAMPED P.A. 345, P.S. NO. 18994 TO GRADE OVER THE AXLE SHAFT IN A MONUMENT BOX.
