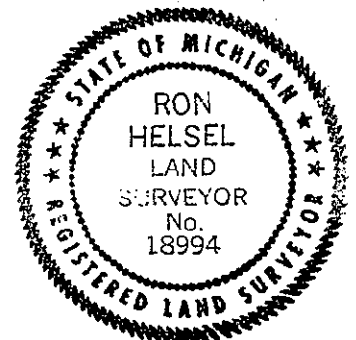
B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

FOUND 1" X 1" X 24" SQUARE IRON PIN WEDGED BETWEEN STONES IN MONUMENT BOX 2' NORTH CENTERLINE OF WILLOUGHBY ROAD AND 1.5 FEET EAST OF A FENCE LINE TO THE SOUTH. FOUND THE MAPLE AND THE ANCHOR POST AS WITNESSED BY I.C.R.C. ACCEPTED THE SQUARE IRON PIN AS A FAITHFUL PERPETUATION MARKER FOR THE CORNER. SET A 1/2 BAR AND CAP STAMPED P.S. NO. 18994 NEXT TO THE PIN TO CONFORM WITH PUBLIC ACT 345. THE SQUARE PIN IS THE MARKER.
