B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Searched at apparent location of Corner and got strong magnetic reading 20' \pm South of A-9 Alaiedon Township. Excavated surface and found Railroad Spike. South of A-9 Alaiedon Township. Excavated surface and found Railroad Spike. Removed Railroad Spike and got strong magnetic reading directly beneath it. Excavated and found 1" Pinchpipe 24" long. Removed 1" pipe and got strong magnetic reading directly beneath it. Excavated to a depth of 3.5 feet and hit another bituminous surface with a hole in it and a 1 1/4" pipe in hole. Excepted Railroad Spike, 1" pipe and 1 1/4" pipe as Corner markers and left 1 1/4" pipe in place and set Standard Bar & Cap above it. Corners lies on centerline of College Road with no occupation line to the West. R. Lester's 30" Poplar Witness to East is still standing and closely matches location of Corner.
