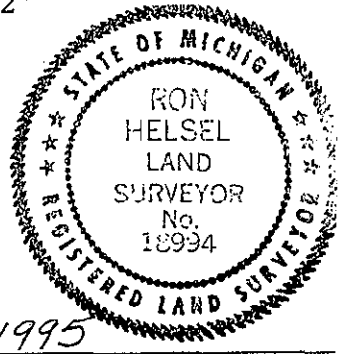

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
 FOUND STEPHENS 1/2" BAR & CAP INSIDE 1 1/2" PIPE ON EAST SIDE OF A STEEL "T" FENCE POST DRIVEN INTO REMAINS OF A ROTTED ANCHOR POST AT THE INTERSECTION OF FENCES NORTH, SOUTH, EAST AND WEST. THE STEEL POST IS RECORDED AS D-1, T3N, R1E IN LIBER 5, PAGE 149 BY A.S. PIERSON NO. 13039. RAYNOR'S SURVEY, "1-A" ABOVE, GAVE A DISTANCE OF 191 RODS, 22 LINKS FROM THIS CORNER TO A-13 ON THE PRINCIPLE MERIDIAN (3166.02') TRAVERSED AND MEASURED FROM D-13 TO A-13 3164.13 FEET. RAYNOR'S MEASUREMENT TO THE CENTER OF SEC. D-12 WAS 160 RODS (2640') MEASURED ± 2646' TO A PILE OF ROCKS AND BROKEN POST. RAYNOR'S MEASURED 180 RODS (2970') TO THE WEST 1/4 COR. OF SEC. 31 A-12 FROM D-12. TRAVERSED AND MEASURED 2971.78'. ACCEPTED STEPHENS MARKER AND LEFT INTACT. COULD'NT MOVE THE 1 1/2" PIPE.
