B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Searched at probable location of the corner from witnesses in items (A) 6 and 7 and found a 1/2" iron pipe in monument box. The corner lies on a small hill that has a 3' to 5' cut section according to long time area residents. Accepted the pipe as corner location as best available evidence.

- 4. Surveyor Richard Steadman LS # 11370 reported using the corner on Nov. 29, 1976 and recorded in Liber 2 of Surveys, Page 944 with the same monument and witnesses as in item 6 below:
- 5. Surveyor Steadman again reported using the corner on March 16, 1978 and recorded in Liber 3 of Surveys, Page 272 with the same monument and witnesses as in item 6 below:
