B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Searched at probable location of the corner and found a 1/2" bar with cap #18998 at North side of a 4 way fence corner matching witnesses from items 3 and 7 above. Excavated around the iron and found a 15 lb. stone with two bricks beneath it at North side of iron. Accepted stone as the corner set by Drake in 1879. Replaced 1/2" Bar & Cap with standard bar & cap.
