B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I-11, Investigation at this corner location revealed a 4" square concrete monument with 1/2" bar ±18' East of tree line. All of the witness trees Fouty called for in Item #2 above remained including one of his tags in the 16" Walnut S14°W. A Stephens' tag was found close to the distance called for by Fouty in the 10" Elm Southwest. Another 4" square concrete monument with 1/2" bar was found South 144.36 feet in a Northwest-Southeast fence on the North side of railroad tracks. This monument is shown on the plat of Sylvan Glen Subdivision. The location of the witnessed monument was therefore accepted as the perpetuated location of I-11.
