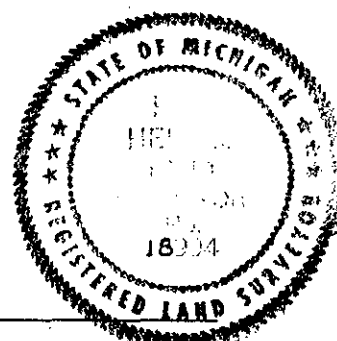

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

FOUND A 10' X 10' SQUARE HOLE PATCH AT THE INTERSECTION OF ALLEN AND MORRICE ROADS. FOUND AN ILLEGIBLE CAP AND 1/2" X 24" REBAR 2.0 FEET EAST OF THE C/L OF MORRICE ROAD AND 2.0 FEET SOUTH OF THE C/L OF ALLEN ROAD. EXCAVATED THROUGH OLD ASPHALT PATCH, WHICH APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN LAID 20 YEARS AGO, DOWN 3.2 FEET TO THE OLD CLAY ROAD BED. FOUND BRICK & A FLAT STONE IN AN UPRIGHT POSITION, 4" X 18" X 8", UNDER THE 1/2" REBAR. ALSO FOUND A CAPPED 14" BOAT SPIKE LYING FLAT BETWEEN THE REBAR AND STONE. ACCEPTED THE STONE AS NOTED BY THE COUNTY SURVEYORS DRAKE AND McCREARY. RAISED STONE & SOME OF THE BRICK AND SET A STANDARD 3/4" FORM PIN AND INGHAM COUNTY DISK STAMPED P.A. 345, P.S. NO. 18994 IN A MONUMENT BOX.

SET 1/2" BAR AND CAP 6" OFF THE BACK OF & IN THE MIDDLE OF CURB, AZ. 45°, 40.11 FEET
SET NAIL & TAG, NORTH SIDE OF 40" OAK IN BLAZE MARK, AZ. 148°, 95.72 FEET
FOUND FOUTY BAR & CAP, 33.0 FEET SOUTH OF P.K. NAIL (K-1 LEROY TWP.), AZ. 148°, 39.69 FEET
K-1 LEROY TWP. 3/4" FORM PIN AND STANDARD DISK, AZ. 88°, 21.12 FEET
