A wood post was set witnessed by a 26" Beech S50°W 25 links and a 10" Beech N60°E 11 links. This was set in 1827. There is no County Surveyors record of perpetuation of this corner. In May of 1978 Professional Surveyor, Paul VanKooten #8618 set a T iron at the intersection of fences. This is recorded in Liber 2, page 22 Ionia Records. B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner; No early historical evidence was found here. Found T iron and accepted this as the position of C-2. A 3/4" x 36" steel rod was set over the T iron. C.
