I, Marinus Mulder, in a field survey on October 6, 1993, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 This corner was first established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor, Noah Brookfield in 1837. A wood post was set witnessed by a 30" White Oak N 34° W 26 links and a 10" White Oak N 11° E 78 links.
 Perpetuation: A.C. Smith former Ionia County Surveyor performed work in Section 26, T7N-R8W and "reset the Southwest section corner" April 30th 1875. Remains of the G.L.O. bearing trees were still there. He did not say what he set. The witnesses were 12" White Oak S 51° E 67 1/4 links and a 5" White Oak S 27 1/2° W 66 links. D.C. Crawford former Ionia County Surveyor made a marginal notation in the County Surveyors copy of the G.L.O. notes that he found the corner in 1903 and 1911. *Continued*

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

One of A.C. Smith's 1875 witness trees still remain being the White Oak 67 1/4 links Southeast. The witness distance was measured and the road excavated. About 16" below the surface stones, crockery, glass and plates of tin were found. Accepted this as the corner, and set a 3/4" steel rod and cap in center.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 3/4" x 24" steel bar with a 2 3/4" diameter cap stamped "P.S. 25863"

 Nail & tag East side 54" Oak N 27° W 49.15'
 Nail & tag Northeast side 42" Oak S 45° E 45.58' (Smith's 1875 witness tree)
 Nail & tag Northwest side 50" Oak stump S 58° W 42.83 feet
 Nail & tag West side 48" Oak S 8° E 79.84'
 Wickham's recorded pipe is West 0.22 feet and North 2.21 feet.

Continued from A: Professional Surveyor Burt Wickham Jr. No. 17639 recorded I-11 on September 15, 1987 found in Liber 2 page 282. Wickham stated there was no evidence of original corner or accessories found, and goes on to say he found a 1" iron pipe in centerline x of roads.

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
