PERPETUATION: D.C. CRAWFORD FORMER IONIA COUNTY SURVEYOR PERFORMED A SURVEY OF SECTION 32, JUNE 8, 1895, SURVEY NO. 32, RECORDED IN VOLUME 2, PAGE 334 OF IONIA COUNTY SURVEYORS RECORDS. CRAWFORD DID NOT SHOW ANY INFORMATION FOR C-13.

THE IONIA COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION IMPROVED HAYS ROAD IN 1950 PROJECT CS-34-58. NO INFORMATION WAS FOUND ON THE PLANS FOR C-13. THE ROAD COMMISSION HAS WITNESSES FOR C-13 IN THE COUNTY WITNESS INDEX SHEETS AS FOLLOWS: 1/2" ROD- SIGN POST S.E. 69.0 FEET; FENCE CORNER POST N.W. 40.55 FEET.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: AT THE INTERSECTION OF HAYES ROAD AND NICKEL PLATE ROAD FOUND ONE ROAD COMMISSION WITNESS (SIGN POST) REMAINS. MEASURED DISTANCE AND EXCAVATED ROAD BED. 2" BELOW THE SURFACE FOUND A 1/2"x18" ROD. BELOW THE ROD FOUND A 3/4"x10" BOAT SPIKE ABOVE 2 MEDIUM SIZE STONES. ACCEPTED THIS AS THE PERPETUATED CORNER.
