Pisoni 5 that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned 6 in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the 8 corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, 10 re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Original corner established by Austin Burt,, U.S. Deputy Surveyor on July 31,1846. Original corner: Wood Post Original bearing trees: White Pine 16" S 03° E 24 links (15.84 feet) Yellow Pine 18" S 29° W 31 links (20.46 feet) N 10° W White Pine 25 links (16.50 feet) N 27° E White Pine 34 links (22,44 feet) Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: No original corner evidence found. Area was heavily burned in early 1900's. Found a wood post located on South end of a wire fence line which has been used as the section corner, but post is too far out of position to be acceptable as the section corner. The wood post on the fence line is S 58°28'E and 235.26 feet from another wood post found lying on ground which is the section corner position. Post found is 5" in dia. and marking corner position. From wood post, GLO distances East, West, North and South check good to other GLO corners. PEER GROUP APPROVED THE MENT J. Progr. 13-11-96 COUNTY REPRESENTATIVE I accept the wood post as the best available evidence for restoring corner position. Corner Record Research on file with County Representative. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Replaced wood post and set a 2" diameter by 30" long split base aluminum pipe monument with a 3" cast aluminum cap, stamped to read: Iron County Remonumentation, T42N, R33W, S-34, S-35, S-3, S-2, T41N, 1996, RLS-27457 from which I established the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees: (all measurements taken to a nail in side of tree) Black Cherry 6" Clump N 31° E 65.96 feet Black Cherry 6" Clump N 85° E R 00 4---STATE OF MICHIGAN 6" Clump Black Cherry N 85° E 88.98 feet 8" **PISONI** S 25° W Aspen 55.50 feet LAND 7" N 32° W Aspen 55.24 feet SURVEYOR
