A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(E12) Quarter corner common to Sections 32-33. Corner established in 1849 by John Burt as follows: "Set Hemlock or 8 post. Hemlock 12 M48E 18, do 14 S34W 16". Corner remonumented in the 1940's by Wisconsin Michigan Power Company as follows: "Set concrete marker, Checks to river 1 mile north and S. 1/2 mile. 5" Pop. 883W 9.9", 4" Pop. W48E 2.5", 3" Pop. 835E 5.8". Found no subsequent record. (F13) Quarter corner common to Section 33 T42W-R31W and Section 4 T41W-R31W. Corner established in 1848 by Wm A. Burt as follows: "Set Hemlock post of Sec. cor. Hem. 18 M58E 25, W. Pine 40 M10W 23". Corner remonumented in the 1940's by Wisconsin Michigan Power Company as follows: "Found old Sq. tree. Set pipe marker. 24" Y. Sirch S23E 46.5", 8" Pop. M45E 23.4". Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(E12) Found the WMPCO monument - a truncated right-rectangular concrete pyramid, of unknown depth, containing ferrous material, with a 3 1/2° dia. stanged brass tablet set in the top, in good condition. Mone of the WMPCO MBTs were recovered. Distance north to WMPCO monument at the section corner was determined to be 39.844 ch.(40.00 ch. original record). Made no further attempted to verify the WMPCO position. Marked 4 new witnesses as described below.

(F13) Recovered the WMPCO monument at record bearing and distance from the remaining MBT, the Y. Birch, now stump remains. The monument is in good condition. Made no further attempt to verify the WMPCO position. Left the monument in place and marked 4 new bearing trees as described below.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(E12) Found a Concrete monument with 3
1/2" dia. WMPCO tablet. Blazed and
scribed the following bearing trees:

10" twin Maple M37E 19.7" "1/4S M8T" 6" Maple \$25W 34.9" "1/4S M8T" 10" twin Maple \$84W 37.7" "1/4S M8T" 6" Maple M28W 25.5" "1/4S M8T" Bearings are magnetic.
