Corner F7: Neither physical evidence on the ground nor measurements to known corners in this township support the found wood post; therefore, on June 22, 1971, I reestablished the corner on line between section corners 39.810 ch. to E and to W.						
Corner 16: The found post was evidently supposed to be midway on line between found posts at 1/4 corner and section corner, and while nearly equidistant, is far north of being on a line between them. On May 8, 1972, I re-established this corner on line between new section corner 19.905 ch. E and new 1/4 corner 19.905 ch. W.
