No evidence of original corner or bearing tree remains. Corner position found marked by a 3/4" X 28" iron pin. Corner position has been used and accepted locally, for many years. Set an aluminum pipe monument over the top of iron pin as described below. Monument is 3" above ground surface.

This corner is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

Corner located on fence line running East and North and in line with centerline of a county road running South.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
