B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

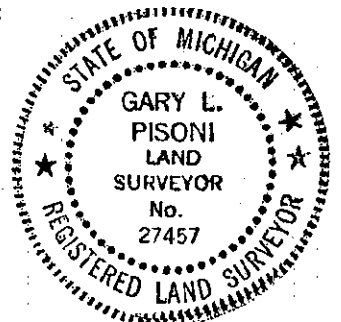
No original corner evidence found.
Accept the intersection of the centerline of Buck Lake road running North & South and an old fence line running East as the best available evidence for restoring the corner position.
Section line to the West, runs down the North edge of Buck Lake Park road.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position, I set a 5/8" by 30" long rebar pin with a 3" cast aluminum cap, 6" below road bed surface, stamped to read: Iron County Remonumentation, T42N, R33W, S-13; S-14 S-23, S-24, 1996, RLS - 27457 from which I established the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees:
