A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by Harvey Mellen, U.S. Deputy Surveyor on August 20, 1851. Original corner: Wood post Original bearing trees: s 32°W 8 links (5.28 feet) Sugar Maple 14" 19 links (12.54 feet) Yellow Birch

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No evidence of original corner or bearing tree remains. Corner position found marked by a 5" X 44" cylindrical plat concrete monument of Camp Lake. Concrete monument in poor condition, reset with an aluminum pipe monument as described below. Monument is 3" above ground surface. Corner position has been used and accepted as the corner locally, for many years. Layed plat concrete monument next to monument.

This corner is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position, I set a 2" diameter by 30" long split base aluminum pipe monument with a 3" cast aluminum cap, stamped to read: Iron County Remonumentation, T42N, R35W, 1/4, S-7, S-18, 1993, R.L.S. 27457; from which I established the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees: (all measurementstaken to a nail in side
