A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(M2) Quarter corner common to Section 1 T43M-R31W, and Section 8 T43M-R30W. Original record states: Set Memlock post, Tamarack 10 S80W 52, Spruce 10 N75W 61. Corner subsequently recorded by Thomas P. O'Brian in 1977 as: Found pipe with Kimberly Clark cap: 8° Spruce N32W 8.2', 8' Spruce \$40E 4.4', 6' Spruce \$70W 4.4'.

[7-Sec. 1] North 1/18 corner between Section 1 T43M-R31W and Section 6 T43M-R30W. Corner not astablished in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

(M2) Found and accepted a 2' dia. from pips, pinched on lower and, set by unknown surveyor, presumably long ago. O'Brien's record of K-C monument at this corner seems to be arroneous. Recovered the stump mound remains of both original bearing trees at record bearing and distance, both in advanced stages of decay and no markings visible. The pipe is located at an old fance corner with old wire fances extending to the north and east. An old mitness pipe of similar description was found \$480 47.60' from the corner, Replaced the pipe with a 1°1.0.x32° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped, firmly set, projecting 12', leaning slightly easterly. The center punch on the cap is marking the corner position. Set the 2' pipe adjacent on the west side. Remeasured the 1977 NBTs and set one new KBT as described below.

(7-Sec. 1) found no monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner at 20 chains proportionate to the original record (1330.65') north of the Quarter corner common to Sections 1-6 and on a straight line between the Quarter corner and the Township corner (1290.07') to the north. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1'1.0.x32" iron gipe capped with a 4" dig. cast gluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately atamped, projecting 12".

C Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner

(M2) Set 1" pipe with 4" MDNR cap. found measuring nails in side blazes in the following trees (all marked with a small face blaze): 6" Spruce \$20E 4.34" 4' Spruce \$550 4.88' 7" Spruce N30W 8.26" Added the following, marked in a similar STARRET: 7 Spruce M53E 12.61'.

(7) Set 1" pipe with 4" MDNR cap. Blazed and scribed the following bearing trees: 9" Sugar S73E 4.1' "1/165 BT" 16" Hemlock \$17W 47.4" "1/16S BT" 8" double Sugar M59W 18.0" "1/16S BT" 8' Sugar N39E 41.5' °1/165 BT' 1.5° 1.0. iron pipe M58E 54' Old N-S barbed wire fence is 43' east Set a 2" squared sugar post adjacent.
