Found a Marathon brass capped iron pipe marking corner position. Distances East and West are consistant with GLO distances. I accept the brass capped iron pipe as the best available evidence for restoring the corner position. Corner record research on file with County Representative. C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: International Actions of Michigan Control of M At the corner position, replaced brass cap with a 2" diameter by 30" long split base aluminum pipe monument, with a 3" dia. aluminum cap stamped as follows: Iron County Remonumentation, T43N, R32W, 1/4 S-9, S-16, 1999, RLS 27457 from which I established the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees:(All measurements taken to a nail in side of tree) Black Spruce 6" N 14°E 21.28 feet 11" S 87°E Red Maple 11.61 feet Balsam 6" S 58°W 8.31 feet 4" N 40°W Black Spruce 20.04 feet Steel sign post 0.65 feet South Ļ
