B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No evidence of original corner or bearing tree remains. Corner Position found marked by a 3/4" by 5' iron pin. Corner position has been used and accepted locally, for many years. Set an aluminum pipe monument as described below. Set iron pin next to monument. Monument is 3" above ground surface. Ironopin was previously recorded in Liber 6, page 240.

This corner is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position, I set a 2" diameter by 30" long split base aluminum pipe monument with a 3" cast aluminum cap, stamped to read: Iron County Remonumentation, T43N, R33W, 1/4, S-27, S-26, 1993, RLS 27457 from which I established the following

new blazed and scribed bearing trees: (all measurements taken to a nail in side of tree)
