Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: No original corner evidence was recovered. Found corner marked by a 3/4" diameter bolt, 12 inches long, located in the Center-Line of an un-improved road running North and South and on a fence line running East and West. I accept the bolt as the best available evidence for restoring the corner position. Corner record research on file with County Representative. C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: In place of iron bolt, set a 5/8 inch diameter rebar, 30 inches long, with a 3 inch diameter aluminum cap, 6 inches below the roadbed surface. Cap is stamped as follows; Iron County Remonumentation, T43N, R34W, 1/4, S18, S19, 1997, RLS 27457.
