A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by Harvey Mellen, U.S. Deputy Surveyor in 1851.

Original corner: Wood Post

Original bearing trees:

s 80°w 10" 5 links (3.30 feet) Sugar Maple S 64 E 6" 9 links (5.94 feet) Ironwood

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No evidence of original corner or bearing tree remains. Corner position found marked by a 3/4" X 32" Iron pin. Iron pin located on East-West fence line and a fence line running South. Corner position has been used and accepted as the corner locally, for many years. Set an aluminum pipe monument over the top of iron pin as described below. Monument is flush with ground surface.

This corner is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position, I set a 2" diameter by 30" long split base aluminum pipe monument with a 3" cast aluminum cap, stamped to read: Iron County Remonumentation, T43N, R35W, 1/4, S-9, S-16, 1993, R.L.S. 27457; from which I established the following

new blazed and scribed bearing trees: (all measurements taken to a nail inside of tree)

Sugar Maple 8" N 75 E 30.45 feet

Sugar Maple 10" S 08 E 13.76 feet
