

Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration; (39) Quarter corner common to Sections 23-26. Corner established in 1849 by John Burt: "Set qr. Sec. post, Y. Birch 4 M32E 23, Fir 12

\$54W 11". Corner shown on a map prepared for Misconsin Michigan Power Company titled "Michiganme River-Way Storage Dam Land Ties and Benchmarks' by Holland, Ackerman, and Holland Rev. 12/7/53, map8 G-154-GG. Corner is described as "Set concrete monument with brass cap. 6" Pop NSBE 68.0', 12" P.Stump S35E 43.4', 2" Pop. NS2N 18.7'". Found no subsequent record.

(3-Sec. 24) North 1/16 corner between Sections 23-24. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

(J9) Original post and accessories not recovered. Recovered the MMPCO monument, a 7" truncated right rectangular concrete pyramid with a 3' sq. brass tablet affixed on top stamped "Wisconsin Michigan Power Company 44-31 1/4 23,26". The WMPCO witnesses were not recovered. The position of the monument is reasonable compared to section corner monuments east and west. I accepted the monument as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. Left the monument in place and marked four new mitnesses as described below. Corner witnessed by B.Wheeler and D.Lampela, Baraga District Office, MOHR.

(3-Sec. 24) Found no swidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner midway and on a line of mean true bearing between between Section corner 1317.3' north and Quarter corner 1317.3' South. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1' I.D. x 32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by D.Lampela and 8. Wheeler, Baraga District Office, MONA. The corner is located in an aspen cutting about 50' M. of E. edge.
