A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established in 1851 by Guy H. Carleton, U.S. Deputy Surveyor.

 Cedar 12" S 60° W 12 lks (7.92 feet)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No evidence of original B.T.s found. Found a nail marking corner position, 2" below asphalt surface, located in the centerline of an East/West county road and in the centerline of a road running North and South.

Distances to adjoining corners are consistent with GLO distances.

I accept the nail as the best available evidence for restoring the corner position.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

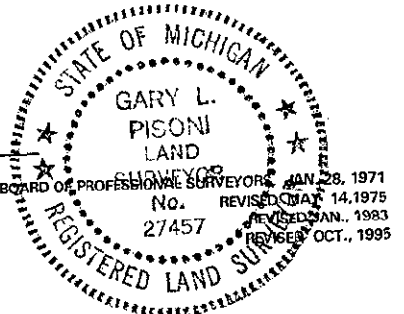
From the above described corner position, I set two reference monuments, being a 5/8" diameter by 30" long rebar, with a 3" aluminum cap stamped as follows: Iron County Remonumentation, T44N, R33W, R.M., S-5, S-6, S-7, S-8, S 46° W, 27.16 feet, 1998, RLS 27457; T44N, R33W, R.M., S-5, S-6, S-7, S-8, N 55° W, 40.30 feet, 1998, RLS 27457 from which I blazed and scribed the following new bearing trees: (All measurements taken to a nail in side of tree)
