No evidence of original B.T.s found.

Found a 4" diameter brass cap with MDNR Fisheries Division identification set by G.A. Shadko RLS on 12/18/62. Monument flush with ground surface and located on a rock fence line running North, East and West, stamped as follows: DNR, T44N, R33W, S-25, S-26, S-35, S-36, 12/18/62, G.A. Shadko RLS.

I accept the monument as the best available evidence for restoring the corner position.

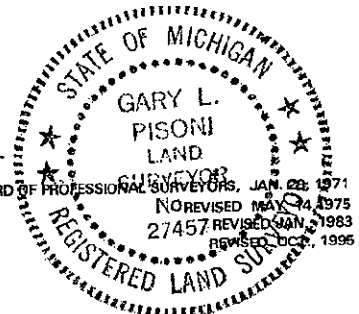
