A. Description of priorial monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(C9) Corner compon to Sections 19-20-29-30. Corner previously recorded in 1982 by Kieth Sackett, RLS as follows: Set 1° I.D.x32° IP with 4° aluminum cap at post set from original bearing tree. 1982 NBTs: 6° Spruce SS2N 18.0', 5° Spruce S77E 9.8', 5° Balsan M54E 4.91. Found no subsequent record.

(7-Sec. 19) North 1/16 corner between Sections 19-20. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record. (14-Sec. 18) South 1/16 corner between Sections 18-17. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C9) Found and accepted corner unnument as previously recorded at record bearing and distance from the 2 spruce NBTs, both in good condition. The Balsan MBT had come down. Marked 2 new witnesses trees as described below.

(7-Sec. 19) Established the corner midway and on a straight line between Section and Quarter corners 1320.23' north and south. Found an 8" dead maple \$29E 21.9' with a location poster dated 1980 for a forester's approximate corner. At the position for the corner, placed a 1"x36" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. The center of a road, which bears MSSE, is morth 29 ft. from the corner. The corner falls about 45' east of the east adge of a R. Pine plantation.

(14-Sec. 18) found no evidence of prior conventation. Established the corner on a straight line between quarter and section corners 1329.23' north and south. At the position for the corner, placed a 1"x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MONR tablet. appropriately stamped.
